

INCLUSIONS

- Welcome ceremony, assembly and school tour
- A 'buddy' an Australian student of a similar age as the visiting student
- Conversational English lessons given by a qualified teacher (one teacher for every 20 students)
- Classes with Australian students
- Costs associated with excursions

- Participation certificate for each student
- One adult for every 10 students is free of charge

GROUP SIZE

- Minimum group size is 10 students
- Large groups may be hosted by two or more schools

AGE

• Students must be at least 10 years of age

- accommodation for one or two students (single or double placement cannot be guaranteed)
- three meals a day
- transport to and from school.
